Gerald Wheeler is Executive Director of the National Science Teachers Association. Previously, he was a Professor of Physics at Montana State University, Director of the MSU Science/Math Resource Center, Professor of Physics at Temple University, and Program Director for the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) in the area of Public Understanding of Science and Technology. Wheeler received his B.S. from Boston University with a major in science education and his Ph.D. at the State University of New York (SUNY) at Stony Brook in experimental nuclear physics. Between undergraduate and graduate school, he taught high school physics, chemistry and physical science. Wheeler is the recipient of numerous awards for his teaching and mass media work, including outstanding teaching awards from Temple University, the University of Hartford, and Montana State University, as well as the AAPT's prestigious Milliken Award. Wheeler is a former President of the American Association of Physics Teachers, a Fellow of the W.K. Kellogg Foundation and the AAAS.
